SMM Regulations

Safe Management Measures in National Junior College

- •The Safe Management Measures (SMM) are aligned with our national posture for containing the spread of Covid-19 and are for strict compliance.
- •As the increase in visitors to school would pose additional risk to staff and students, NJC would need to adapt the conduct of these activities to minimise the duration and number of parents/guardians that need to be in schools.
- •We will be following **additional** safe management measures (SMM) on top of existing visitor management guidelines to mitigate the risk level.
- As such we will be using online alternatives such as webinars to replace all mass briefings.





SMM Regulations

Safe Management Measures (SMM) for Visits to School by 2021 JH1 Parents/Guardians

The following guidelines should be observed for all visits to the school by parents/guardians:

- Parents/ guardians should not turn up in school unannounced. Students should be accompanied by at most one parent/guardian
- You will need to fill out the form https://go.gov.sg/kbdnmn at least 1 day before your scheduled arrival to NJC
- Parents/guardians should only enter the school only on days where current students need not report to school (provide dates)
- Entry is via the Main Gate along Hillcrest Road only
- Safe distancing of 1m should be maintained at all times between different groups of parents/guardians and students.
- All Administrative Tasks should be conducted online.

- MONDAY 11 Jan 2021, 7.30 am, NJC Hall
- Orientation Programme for <u>students</u>
 - Due to the current Covid-19 situation, parents need not, and should not, accompany students
 - No parking is available in NJC, kindly make arrangements for dropping off your child, or use public transport
 - Note that the traffic condition in the vicinity is typically very heavy around that time / from 7.10 am
- Be in NJC school uniform (or primary school uniform if NJC uniform is not yet purchased)



Guidelines for proper usage

- Parental Control: Parents can sign up for Course in Apple Singapore or use Restrictions to block or limit specific apps/features/website on your child's iPad

- Singapore Citizens who do not qualify for subsidies will be allowed to draw down from Edusave Pupil Fund without cap to reduce outof-pocket expenses
