

Guidelines for proper usage


- Classroom application: A powerful tool in helping teachers guide students through a lesson, see their progress, and keep them on track. Features include:
 - Lock devices into a single app
 - Lock Screens to pause work or refocus
 - See what students see










IMAGES OF A M-CLASS SOLAR FLARE
